

WARNING

The legal voters of the Hyde Park Town School District, Vermont, are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Town Offices on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) in the forenoon (a.m.), at which time the polls will open, and seven o'clock (7:00) in the afternoon (p.m.), at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot upon the following Article of business:

The Board of School Directors of Hyde Park Town School District proposes to incur bonded indebtedness for the purpose of construction and necessary school building improvements to the Hyde Park Elementary School. State funds may not be available at the time this project is otherwise eligible to receive state school construction aid. The District is responsible for all costs incurred in connection with any borrowing done in anticipation of the receipt of school construction aid.

ARTICLE I

Shall general obligation bonds or notes of the Hyde Park Town School District in an amount not to exceed Eighteen Million Three Hundred Seven Thousand Dollars (\$18,307,000), subject to reduction from the receipt of available state and federal grants-in-aid, and other financial assistance, be issued for the purpose of financing new construction of classrooms, gymnasium, cafeteria, storage, instructional and office space as well as infrastructure and site improvements at the Hyde Park Elementary School, at an estimated cost of Eighteen Million Three Hundred Seven Thousand Dollars (\$18,307,000)?

The legal voters of the Hyde Park Town School District are further notified that voter qualification, registration and absentee voting relative to said special meeting shall be as provided in Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

The legal voters of the Hyde Park Town School District are further notified that an informational meeting will be held on Monday, Oct. 27, 2014 at the HPES in the Town of Hyde Park at seven o'clock (7:00) in the evening, for the purpose of explaining the proposed improvements and the financing thereof.
