INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS

- Use BLACK PEN or PENCIL to fill in the oval.
- To vote for a person whose name is printed on the ballot, fill in the oval to the right of the name of that person.
- To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write or stick his or her name in the blank space provided and fill in the oval to the right of the write-in line.
- Do not vote for more candidates than the "VOTE for NOT MORE THAN #" for an office.
- If you make a mistake, tear, or deface the ballot, return it to an election official and obtain another ballot. DO NOT ERASE.

Article 1: Shall general obligation bonds or notes of the Hyde Park Town School District in an amount not to exceed Eighteen Million Three Hundred Seven Thousand Dollars (\$18,307,000), subject to reduction from the receipt of available state and federal grants-in-aid, and other financial assistance, be issued for the purpose of financing new construction of classrooms, gymnasium, cafeteria, storage, instructional and office space as well as infrastructure and site improvements at the Hyde Park Elementary School District, at an estimated cost of Eighteen Million Three Hundred Seven Thousand Dollars (\$18,307,000)?
